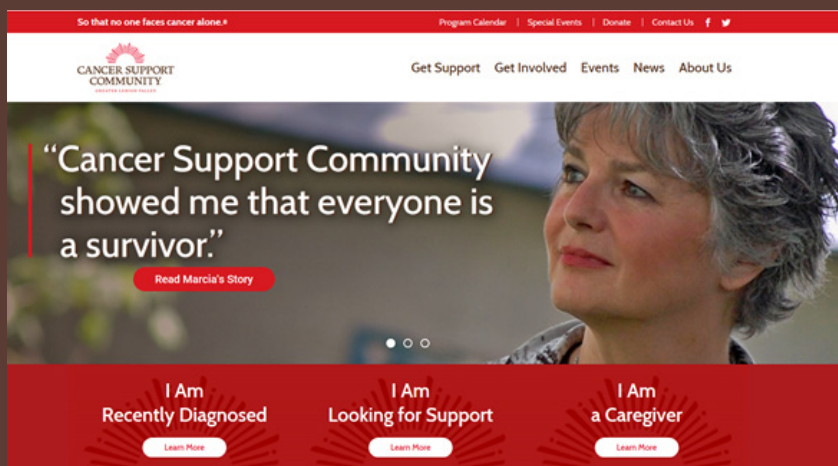


PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

During the 2017-2018 fiscal year, we welcomed and helped **4,546** cancer survivors and family members, 130 of whom were children.

- **62 educational workshops** on topics like nutrition, benefits of physical therapy, legacy planning, medical insurance, medical marijuana, side effects, survivorship care, clinical trials, and budget planning;
- **439 healthy lifestyle/stress reduction classes** including Tai Chi, customized exercise, reiki, meditation, yoga, and expressive arts;
- **41 social programs** such as breakfast meetings, felting/knitting, open art studio, card making, joke night, flower arranging, walking club, and an art exhibit/gallery night;
- In addition to the adult programs, we held **35 children/teen/family activities** including an 8-month martial arts series, expressive arts classes, mindfulness workshops, and retreat days.

Other highlights from the year include a congressional update with **Charlie Dent, Cancer Hope Network mentor training**, and a **Survivor Summit** with over 100 people in attendance.




CANCER HOPE NETWORK

THE BIGGAR FAMILY CENTER

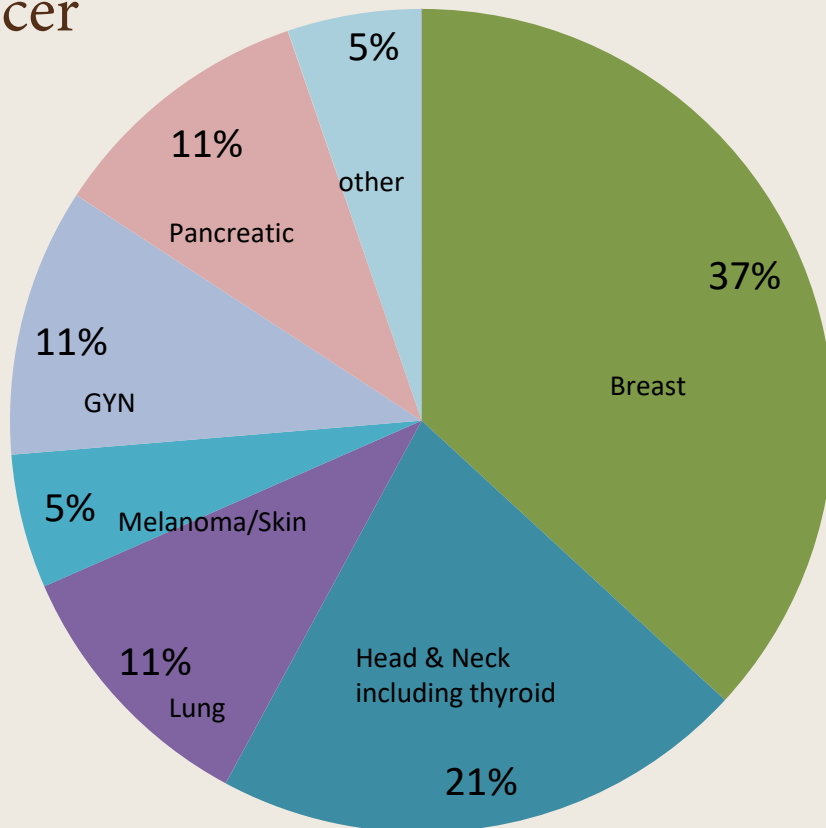

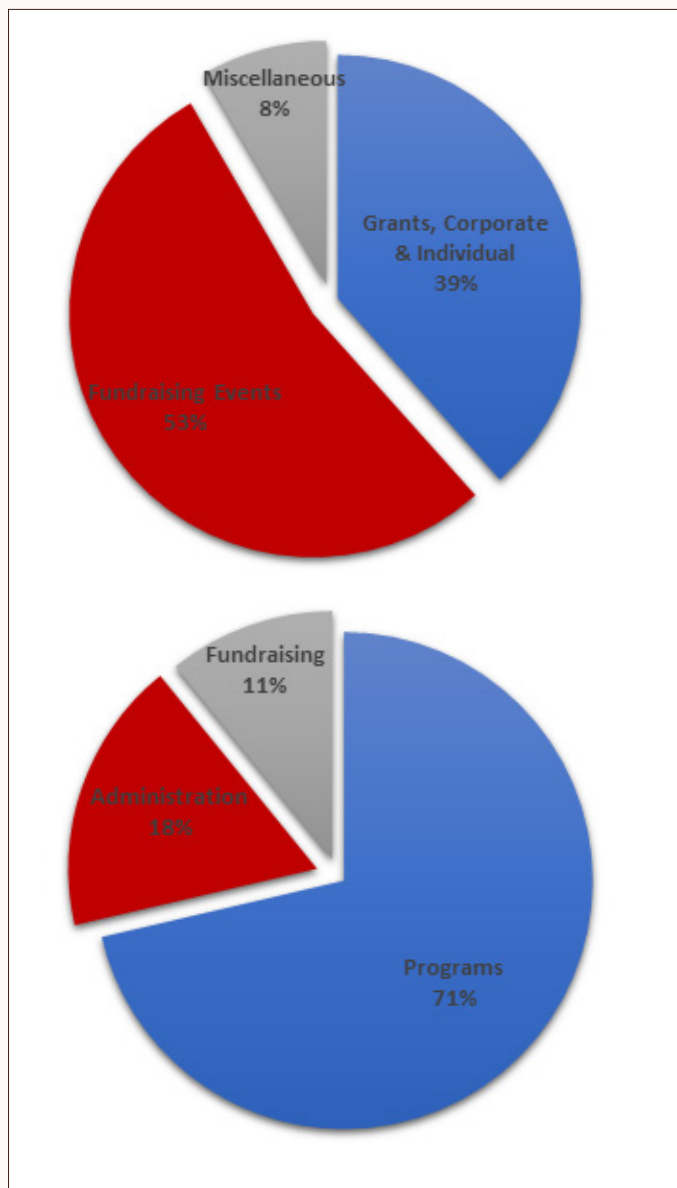
